



RF Alliance and NSWC Crane sign Partnership Intermediary Agreement

The RF Alliance, under Crane Technology Inc., signed a Partnership Intermediary Agreement with NSWC Crane on October 8th, 2009. The RF Alliance is a non-profit chartered organization whose goal is to transition radio frequency technology from the research and academia levels to commercial and military use. The partnership agreement will help facilitate the interactions between the RF Alliance and NSWC Crane by allowing the partners to share resources including experts, equipment, facilities, and intellectual property.
